

Punc-"shoe"-ation!

Trace the shoe pattern on a half sheet of craft foam (available at Wal-Mart for 33 cents per sheet). Carefully cut out the shoe and cut on all lines inside the shoe. Folding it in half will allow you to make a snip and get your scissors inside.

Pull the bottom strap up towards the toe of the shoe and slip the toe point through the slit in the strap. This step is easier if you work it through one pointed side at a time.

Use a black fine-tipped, permanent marker to write the following on the back side of the shoe:

PUNCTUATION

1. Capital letters
2. Periods
3. Exclamation points
4. Question marks
5. Commas in a series
6. Indent first paragraph
7. Quotation marks

This is also a marvelous opportunity to teach puns, since Punc-shoe-ation is obviously a "take off" on the word punctuation. Point out the correct spelling of the word "punctuation" on the back side of the shoe.
